Exercise 3-2

- 1. Start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch using the imperial format. Save the drawing as EX3-2.
- 3. Experiment by drawing lines using the following guidelines and options. Specify all points using the left mouse button, at random locations.
 - Use the LINE command to draw a single line segment by picking two points, then end the command.
 - Draw two connected lines, separate from the existing line, and end the LINE command.
 - Draw one triangle and one rectangle using the **Close** option.
 - Draw eight connected lines. Use the **Undo** option to remove the last four lines, while remaining in the **LINE** command. Finally, draw four new connected lines.
- 4. Resave and close the file.
- 5. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
