Exercise 3-7

- 1. Continue from Exercise 3-6 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX3-7.
- 3. Draw two connected lines and end the **LINE** command. Repeat the **LINE** command and press [Enter] to begin a new line at the last point entry. Pick an endpoint and end the **LINE** command.
- 4. Use the **LINE** command, polar tracking, and direct distance entry to draw a 3-unit square.
- 5. Resave and close the file.
- 6. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
