Exercise 4-12

- 1. Continue from Exercise 4-11 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a decimal-unit template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX4-12.
- 3. Draw a donut with a 1.5 inside diameter and a 4.5 outside diameter.
- 4. Draw a donut with a 0 inside diameter and a 4.5 outside diameter.
- 5. Turn the **FILL** mode off and enter **REGEN** to see what happens to the donuts. (The **REGEN** command regenerates the drawing screen.)
- 6. Turn the **FILL** mode on.
- 7. Draw two more donuts.
- 8. Resave and close the drawing.
- Continue to practice using the **DONUT** command by completing act04-12.dwg available on the companion website.
- 10. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
