Exercise 6-5

- 1. Continue from Exercise 6-4 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open a previous drawing that contains objects.
- 3. Save a copy of the file as EX6-5. The EX6-5 file should be active.
- 4. If the objects in this drawing are drawn using a light color, change their layer color to white.
- 5. Create a new layer called DONUT that uses a light color, such as yellow.
- 6. Draw two donuts on the DONUT layer with an inside diameter of 0 and an outside diameter large enough to cover several of the existing objects. Place the donuts away from each other, over several existing objects.
- 7. Change the draw order of one of the donuts using the **Send to Back** option. Notice the display change.
- 8. Experiment with the draw order of the donut using the other **DRAWORDER** options.
- 9. Resave and close the file.
- 10. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
