## **Exercise 7-6**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 7-5 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX7-6.
- 3. Disable running object snaps.
- 4. Draw a circle, and then draw a line tangent to the circle using the **Tangent** object snap override.
- 5. Draw two additional circles, and then draw a line tangent to both the circles using the **Tangent** object snap override.
- 6. Use the **Tangent** object snap override to draw two lines that are tangent to the circles, but do not cross.
- 7. Activate running object snaps, set the **Tangent** running object snap mode, and recreate the same objects using running object snaps.
- 8. Resave and close the file.
- 9. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
