Exercise 9-4

- 1. Continue from Exercise 9-3 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX9-2 file you saved during Exercise 9-2.
- 3. Save a copy of EX9-2 as EX9-4. The EX9-4 file should be active.
- 4. Double-click on the mtext object to open the text editor.
- 5. Select the entire paragraph and change the height to .125" (3 mm). Change the font from Arial to Romans. Notice that the **Bold** and **Italic** buttons are no longer available because the Romans font is not a TrueType font.
- 6. Change the font for the words MTEXT and text editor back to Arial.
- 7. Make the word MTEXT bold.
- 8. Make the words text editor italic.
- 9. Pick the Close Text Editor button.
- 10. Resave and close the file.
- 11. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
