- 1. Continue from Exercise 10-4 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX10-5.
- 3. Using the **TEXT** command, create three lines of text. Give each line a different height and justification.
- 4. Use the **SCALETEXT** command to scale the text height up to two times the current values.
- 5. Use the **JUSTIFYTEXT** command to change all the text objects to have the same justification setting.
- 6. Resave and close the file.
- 7. Keep AutoCAD open for the chapter review and problems, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
