

Exercise 10-5

1. Continue from Exercise 10-4 or start AutoCAD.
2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX10-5.
3. Using the **TEXT** command, create three lines of text. Give each line a different height and justification.
4. Use the **SCALETEXT** command to scale the text height up to two times the current values.
5. Use the **JUSTIFYTEXT** command to change all the text objects to have the same justification setting.
6. Resave and close the file.
7. Keep AutoCAD open for the chapter review and problems, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
