
Exercise 22-6

- 3. Set the drawing units length precision to 0.00.
- 4. Turn on the Infer Constraints tool.
- Follow the specified steps to draw the views shown. Infer the constraints shown. Draw only the specified objects, and do not add dimensions. Do not create additional constraints.









- 1. Use the **Fillet** option of the **RECTANGLE** command and begin here
 - 6. Resave and close the file.
 - 7. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
