Exercise 33-2

- 1. Continue from Exercise 33-1 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the Cappuccino Express sheet set you created in Exercise 32-2.
- Activate the Sheet List tab of the Sheet Set Manager and double-click on the
 G-01 sheet to open the file and display the layout. Ensure that you are in paper space and that no floating viewport is active.
- 4. Apply a **ZOOM All** operation.
- 5. Access the **VIEW** command and create a new layout view named Elevations. Add the view to the Elevations category and use the **Current display** option.
- 6. Return to the Sheet List tab of the Sheet Set Manager and double-click on the 2 A-01 sheet to open the file and display the layout. Ensure that you are in paper space and that no floating viewport is active.
- 7. Apply a **ZOOM All** operation.
- 8. Access the **VIEW** command and create a new layout view named Floor Plan. Add the view to the Floor Plan category and use the **Current display** option.
- 9. Return to the **Sheet List** tab of the **Sheet Set Manager**. Right-click on the 4 S-02 sheet and pick **Open** to open the file and display the layout. Ensure that you are in paper space and that no floating viewport is active.
- 10. Apply a **ZOOM All** operation.
- 11. Access the **VIEW** command and create a new layout view named Section. Add the view to the Structural category and use the **Current display** option.
- 12. Right-click on the Section sheet view and select **Rename & Renumber...** to display the **Rename & Renumber View** dialog box. Type A in the **Number:** text box, and pick the **OK** button to exit.
- 13. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
