- 1. Continue from Exercise 11-4 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX11-5.
- 3. Draw objects similar to the "Process" objects shown in Figure 11-10, and then use the **BREAK** command to create objects similar to the "Result" objects.
- 4. Draw two horizontal lines and use the **BREAK** command to break each line at one point, as shown in Figure 11-11.
- 5. Draw two circles and two arcs and break each as shown in Figure 11-12.
- 6. Resave and close the file.
- 7. To continue practicing the **BREAK** command, complete act11-05.dwg available on the companion website.
- 8. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
