Exercise 13-13

- 1. Continue from Exercise 13-12 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX13-10 file you saved during Exercise 13-10.
- 3. Save a copy of EX13-10 as EX13-13. The EX13-13 file should be active.
- 4. Create the following layers:
 - A. Name: HIDDEN, Color: Green, Linetype: Hidden
 - B. Name: CENTER, Color: Magenta, Linetype: Center
 - C. Name: TEXT2, Color: 34, Linetype: Continuous
- 5. Draw a hexagon on the HIDDEN layer.
- 6. Draw a rectangle on the CENTER layer.
- 7. Use the MATCHPROP command to paint the layer of the hexagon to the circle.
- 8. Use the **MATCHPROP** command to paint the layer of the rectangle to the line.
- 9. Create a new text style that uses the Stylus BT font and set the style current.
- 10. Set the TEXT2 layer current and use the **TEXT** command with a **Middle center** justification, .25 text height, and rotation angle of 0 to type your name anywhere in the drawing away from other objects.
- 11. Use the **MATCHPROP** command to paint the properties of your name to the words LINE and CIRCLE.
- 12. Resave and close the file.
- 13. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
