Exercise 13-14

- 1. Continue from Exercise 13-13 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX13-13 file you saved during Exercise 13-13.
- 3. Save a copy of EX13-13 as EX13-14. The EX13-14 file should be active.
- 4. Open the EX13-10 file you saved during Exercise 13-10.
- 5. Tile the two open drawings horizontally.
- 6. Select all of the objects in EX13-10.
- Right-click and select Copy with Base Point. Select the center of the circle as the base point.
- 8. Click in the EX13-14 window to make it active.
- 9. Right-click and select **Paste**. Pick a new location for the objects.
- 10. Select the line and circle in EX13-10 and copy them to the Windows Clipboard.
- 11. Use the **Paste as Block** option to paste the objects into EX13-14.
- 12. Pick the newly pasted line or circle and notice that they are selected together as if they were a single object.
- 13. Use the **MATCHPROP** command to paint the properties of the word LINE from EX13-10 to your name in EX13-14.
- 14. Resave and close the files.
- 15. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
