## **Exercise 18-5**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 18-4 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX18-5.
- 3. Set up the appropriate layers, including a layer for annotations.
- 4. Draw objects similar to those in Figure 18-23. Create the multileader styles needed to add the leaders shown. Use the **MLEADER** command to add the leaders.
- 5. Use the **MLEADER** command to do the following. Create multileader styles as needed.
  - Draw a leader using each of the three placement options.
  - Create a multileader style that uses the Block multileader type. Create leaders using the new style.
  - Create a multileader style that uses the None multileader type. Create leaders using the new style.
  - Experiment by adjusting multileader style settings and observe the changes made to existing leaders.
- 6. Resave and close the file.
- 7. To continue practicing using the **MLEADER** command, complete the activity in act18-05.dwg available on the companion website.
- 8. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
