Exercise 20-12

- 1. Continue from Exercise 20-11 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a decimal-unit template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX20-12.
- 3. Set up the appropriate layers, including a layer for dimensions.
- 4. Create the dimensioned objects shown in the Process column in Figure 20-21 using appropriate multileader styles.
- Use grip editing to change the multileaders as shown in the Result column in Figure 20-21.
- 6. Experiment using the **MLEADEREDIT** command to add and remove leader lines.
- 7. Resave and close the file.
- 8. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
