Exercise 22-10

- 1. Continue from Exercise 22-9 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a decimal-unit template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX22-10.
- 3. Turn on the **Infer Constraints** tool.
- 4. Refer to Figure 22-22. Draw the auxiliary view at 45°, as shown.
- 5. Add a fix constraint to the lower-right corner.
- 6. Use the **DCALIGNED** or **DIMCONSTRAINT** command to add the aligned dimensional constraints shown in Figure 22-22.
- 7. Create views similar to those shown in Figure 22-23. Do not relate the views to each other.
- 8. Add a fix constraint to the lower-left corner of the "Object Selection" example.
- 9. Add a fix constraint to Point 1 of the "**3Point** Selection" example.
- 10. Use the **DCANGULAR** or **DIMCONSTRAINT** command to add the angular dimensional constraints shown in Figure 22-23.
- 11. Resave and close the file.
- 12. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
