Chapter 5: Getting Ready to Manage—Read, Discuss, and Analyze Activity

Goals

READ the case study

Nora’s family owns a grocery store. Her parents and brother work constantly to keep the store in business. Nora often bakes after school to add goods to the grocery store. These goods help bring in extra money. Even though Nora is still in the learning process, she is a skilled baker and enjoys making pastries, breads, and other baked goods.
