aerodynamics

The way air moves around objects.

A line of machines, equipment, and workers in a factory that builds a product by passing work from one station to the next until the product is finished.

Ability to float.

Machine creating power by the burning of a fuel (usually a fossil fuel) when exposed to air in an internal chamber.
