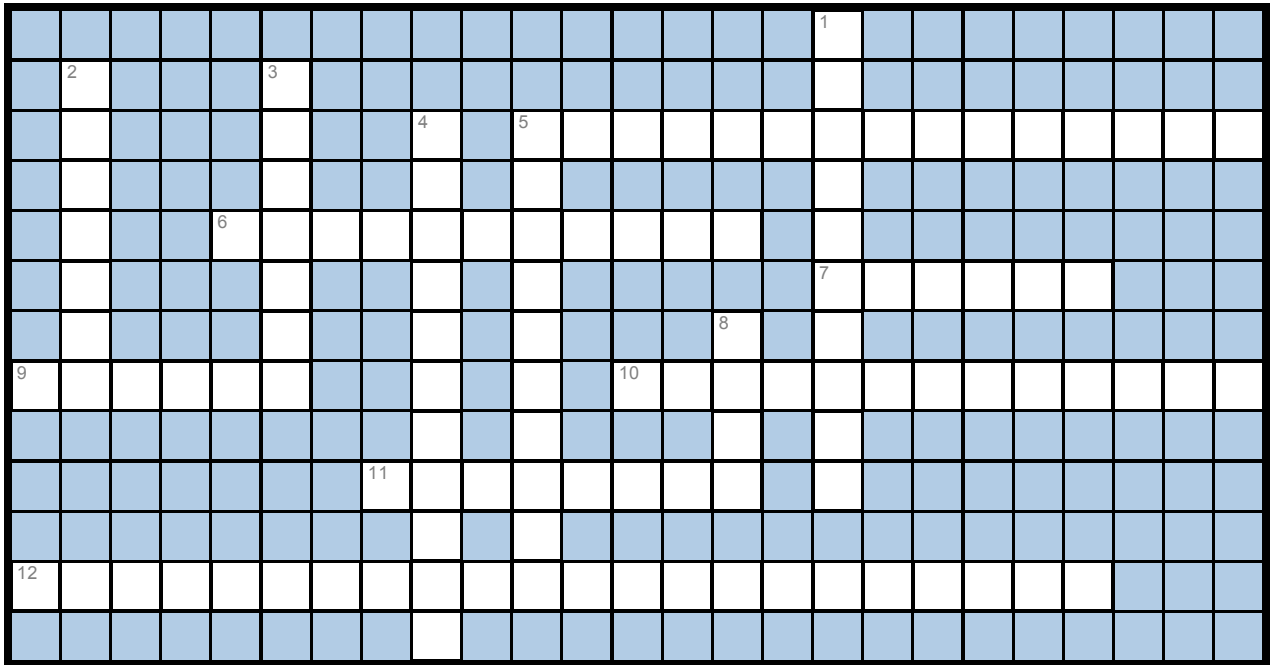


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**Chapter 15: Fabulous Fruits**

- 7. A type of fruit that has one large pit or seed and grows on trees.
- 9. Large, moist fruits that grow on vines and contain seeds. They have a thick skin that may be smooth or rough.
- 10. A type of fruit that grows only in warm, sunny climates.
- 11. A drink that contains water and sugar. Some contain juice; others only fruit flavoring.
- 12. Fresh juice with most of its water removed. Sometimes sugar is added.

- 1. A drink that has natural juice flavor, but may not contain any real fruit juice.
- 2. Fresh fruits and vegetables.
- 3. Small, juicy fruits that contain many tiny seeds.
- 4. A type of fruit that has a leathery skin, many segments filled with juicy pellets, and grows on trees.
- 5. The liquid from squeezed fresh fruit.
- 8. A type of fruit that has a core that contains seeds and grows on trees.
