Exercise 20-14

- 1. Continue from Exercise 20-13 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a decimal-unit template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX20-14.
- 3. Set up appropriate layers, including a layer for dimensions.
- 4. Draw an assembly view similar to the view shown on the right side in Figure 20-24.
- Create a multileader style that uses the **Block** content type and **Circle** source block.
- 6. Use the **MLEADER** command to draw three separate leaders: one tagged 1, another tagged 2, and a third tagged 3. Each leader should touch the hex head screw and point to its center.
- 7. Group the balloons to create the single leader line shown in Figure 20-24.
- 8. Resave and close the file.
- 9. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
