## Exercise 2-1

1. Begin a new drawing based on the acad3D.dwt template.
2. Select the BOX command.
3. Pick a point for the first corner.
4. Use dynamic input to enter coordinate values for the length and width of the box.
5. Use dynamic input to enter a dimensional value for the height of the box.
6. Begin a second box by picking a starting point after issuing the BOX command. Enter an $X$ coordinate value and a comma.
7. Enter the $Y$ and $Z$ values without completing the command. Re-enter the $X Y Z$ values to change the shape and size of the box. Complete the command.
8. Save your drawing as EX2-1.
