## **Exercise 18-4**

- 1. Open the drawing EX18-1 created in Exercise 18-1.
- 2. Place a spotlight with a "from" location away from the objects and the target near the center of the objects.
- 3. If necessary, move the light source in the Z direction so the light points down onto the objects.
- 4. Turn off sunlight.
- 5. Display a pictorial view, if one is not already displayed.
- 6. Render the scene.
- 7. Select the spotlight and, using grips, change the hotspot and falloff properties.
- 8. Render the scene again and note the changes.
- 9. Save the drawing as EX18-4.
