

## Exercise 18-4

1. Open the drawing EX18-1 created in Exercise 18-1.
2. Place a spotlight with a “from” location away from the objects and the target near the center of the objects.
3. If necessary, move the light source in the Z direction so the light points down onto the objects.
4. Turn off sunlight.
5. Display a pictorial view, if one is not already displayed.
6. Render the scene.
7. Select the spotlight and, using grips, change the hotspot and falloff properties.
8. Render the scene again and note the changes.
9. Save the drawing as EX18-4.
