Exercise 6-4

- 1. Continue from Exercise 6-3 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open a previous drawing that contains objects drawn on unique layers.
- 3. Save a copy of the file as EX6-4. The EX6-4 file should be active.
- 4. Notice the appearance of the **Isolate Objects** button on the status bar.
- 5. Experiment by using the **ISOLATEOBJECTS** command to hide all but a few objects. Notice the appearance of the **Isolate Objects** button on the status bar.
- 6. Experiment by using the **HIDEOBJECTS** command to hide a few objects.
- 7. Use the **UNISOLATEOBJECTS** command to return all hidden objects to the display.
- 8. Resave and close the file.
- 9. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
