## Exercise 7-4

1. Continue from Exercise 7-3 or start AutoCAD.
2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX7-4.
3. Disable running object snaps.
4. Draw one horizontal line near the top of the screen.
5. Draw another line near the bottom of the screen that is slightly askew from horizontal.
6. Start to draw a third line, but pick only the first point of the line.
7. Use the Extended Intersection object snap to place the second point of the line at the extended intersection of the first two lines.
8. Resave and close the file.
9. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
