## **Exercise 7-4**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 7-3 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX7-4.
- 3. Disable running object snaps.
- 4. Draw one horizontal line near the top of the screen.
- 5. Draw another line near the bottom of the screen that is slightly askew from horizontal.
- 6. Start to draw a third line, but pick only the first point of the line.
- 7. Use the **Extended Intersection** object snap to place the second point of the line at the extended intersection of the first two lines.
- 8. Resave and close the file.
- 9. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
