## **Exercise 9-7**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 9-6 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX9-7.
- 3. Open the **Text Style** dialog box.
- 4. Create a text style named ARIAL. Set the font to Arial and the height to 0.
- 5. Use the **MTEXT** command and the default column settings to type notes 1.01, 1.02, and 1.03 exactly as shown in Figure 9-34.
- 6. Experiment with creating and adjusting dynamic and static columns in order to form three separate columns. Determine which column option is most effective for placing each note in its own column.
- 7. Resave and close the file.
- 8. Keep AutoCAD open for the chapter review and problems, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
