

Exercise 10-4

1. Continue from Exercise 10-3 or start AutoCAD.
2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX10-4.
3. Use the **MTEXT** command to type the following text exactly as shown:
 1. INTERPRETT DEMINSIONIN AND TOLERENCING PER ANSI Y14.5M–1982.
 2. BURRS AND EDJES REMOV.
 3. ALL PHILLETS AND ROUNDS ARE .125 R.
 4. FINYIS ALL OVER.
4. Close the mtext editor.
5. Reopen the mtext editor. Check the spelling and correct the misspelled words.
6. Close the mtext editor.
7. Reopen the mtext editor. Make additional corrections to change the paragraph to read exactly as shown:
 1. DIMENSIONING AND TOLERANCING PER ASME Y14.5–2009.
 2. REMOVE ALL BURRS AND SHARP EDGES.
 3. FILLETS AND ROUNDS R.125.
 4. FINISH ALL OVER.
8. Resave and close the file.
9. Continue to practice using the AutoCAD spelling tools by completing the activities in act10-4.dwg available on the companion website.
10. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
