Exercise 12-4

- 1. Continue from Exercise 12-3 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX12-1 file you saved during Exercise 12-1.
- 3. Save a copy of EX12-1 as EX12-4. The EX12-4 file should be active.
- 4. Copy the triangle to a location of your choice. Leave a small space between objects.
- 5. Use the **Displacement** option of the **COPY** command to copy the triangle at a displacement of 2,4.
- 6. Copy the square from a base point of your choosing using the first point as the displacement. Notice the position of the new square relative to the original.
- 7. Make four copies of the square anywhere on the screen. The new copies should not touch other objects.
- 8. Resave and close the file.
- 9. Continue to practice using the **COPY** and **MOVE** commands by completing act12-04.dwg available on the companion website.
- 10. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
