- 1. Continue from Exercise 20-4 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a decimal-unit template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX20-5.
- 3. Set up appropriate layers, including a layer for dimensions.
- 4. Draw and dimension the object shown on the left in Figure 20-9A using an appropriate dimension style.
- 5. Copy the object and dimensions to the right of the original.
- 6. Use the **Oblique** option of the **DIMEDIT** command to edit the dimensions on the copied object as shown on the right in Figure 20-9A.
- 7. Resave and close the file.
- 8. To continue practicing using the **DIMEDIT** command, complete the activity in act20-05.dwg available on the companion website.
- 9. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
