## **Exercise 23-2**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 23-1 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a decimal template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX23-2.
- 3. Set up the appropriate layers, including a layer for hatch patterns.
- 4. Draw objects similar to those shown in Figure 23-13 and then create a copy of the objects.
- 5. Use the **Pick Points** option of the **HATCH** command and the default settings to add the hatch pattern shown in Figure 23-13 to the original objects.
- Use the Select Boundary Objects option of the HATCH command and the default settings to add the hatch pattern shown in Figure 23-13 to the copied objects.
- 7. Resave and close the file.
- 8. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
