## **Exercise 23-6**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 23-5 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX23-1 file you saved during Exercise 23-1.
- 3. Save a copy of EX23-1 as EX23-6. The EX23-6 file should be active.
- 4. Create a closed object of your own design.
- 5. Access the HATCH command and change the pattern and several properties to values different from any you have used before. Pick the Match Properties Use the Current Origin Point button. Pick a hatch pattern on the drawing that is different from the current hatch pattern settings. Notice that the name and settings of the selected pattern become current. Apply the hatch pattern to the new object.
- 6. Resave and close the file.
- 7. Continue to practice using the **HATCH** command by completing the activity in act23-06.dwg.
- 8. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
