Exercise 24-7

- 1. Continue from Exercise 24-6 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX24-3 file you saved during Exercise 24-3.
- 3. Save a copy of EX24-3 as EX24-7. The EX24-7 file should be active.
- 4. Insert the CHAIR block anywhere in the drawing.
- 5. Explode the chair you just inserted.
- 6. Add a simple feature to the chair, such as a headrest.
- 7. Create a block named CHAIR from the revised chair.
- 8. Confirm that you want to redefine the block and pick the same insertion point used by the original CHAIR block.
- 9. When the **BLOCK** operation is complete, all of the chairs should update to reflect the changes.
- 10. Resave and close the file.
- 11. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
