
AutoCAD and Its Applications BASICS

Exercise 25-2

- 1. Continue from Exercise 25-1 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX25-1 file you saved during Exercise 25-1.
- 3. Save a copy of EX25-1 as EX25-2. The EX25-2 file should be active.



- 4. Insert the VALVE block into the drawing three times. Accept the default attribute values. Align the blocks horizontally as shown in the figure.
- 5. Select the **Display All Attributes** (**ON**) option of the **ATTDISP** command to display all attributes.
- 6. Use the **Edit Attributes** dialog box or the **Enhanced Attribute Editor** to change the attribute values to those listed in the table below. Assume the blocks are numbered 1 to 3, from left to right.

- 7. Resave and close the file.
