## **AutoCAD and Its Applications BASICS**

## **Exercise 2-1**

- 1. Start AutoCAD. You should see the **Create** page of the **Start Tab**.
- 2. Pick the **No Template Imperial** option from the **Templates** drop-down list in the **Get Started** section to start a new drawing from scratch.
- 3. Pick the **Close** button in the upper-right corner of the drawing window to close the drawing file. Do not save any changes made to the file.
- 4. Select the New button on the Quick Access toolbar to display the Select template dialog box. Examine the contents and features of the Select template dialog box. Pick the Open button to begin a new drawing using the default acad.dwt template.
- 5. Select the **Close** button in the **Application Menu** to close the current file. Do not save any changes made to the file.
- 6. Pick the New button in the Application Menu to display the Select template dialog box. Begin a new drawing from scratch using the Open with no Template Imperial option.
- 7. Save the drawing as EX2-1 and close the file.
- 8. Exit AutoCAD. Restart AutoCAD for the next exercise if you plan to continue working.
