## **AutoCAD and Its Applications BASICS**

## **Exercise 6-3**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 6-2 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open a previous drawing that contains objects.
- 3. Do not use the **ZOOM** navigation command during this step. Use realtime zooming to zoom in and zoom out.
- 4. Access steering wheels.
- 5. Pick the **REWIND** wedge once and notice the display. You should see the brackets move over the previous frame identified by the rewind icon.
- 6. Use the **ZOOM** navigation command to zoom in and out.
- Use the CENTER navigation command to pan to a point on an object of your choice.
- 8. Use realtime panning to adjust the display.
- Experiment with using the REWIND navigation command by pressing and holding the REWIND wedge and rewinding through previous displays. Restore a display of your choice.
- 10. Close the drawing without saving changes.
- 11. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
