## **Exercise 9-5**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 9-4 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX9-4 file you saved during Exercise 9-4.
- 3. Save a copy of EX9-4 as EX9-5. The EX9-5 file should be active.
- 4. Double-click on the mtext object to open the text editor.
- 5. Change the text boundary justification to a few different options to see the results. Change the justification back to top left.
- 6. Type a new paragraph. Type any text of your choice.
- 7. Select some text and set its tracking value to 2.
- 8. Pick the Close Text Editor button.
- 9. Resave and close the file.
- 10. Continue to practice using the **MTEXT** command by completing the activity in act09-05.dwg available on the companion website.
- 11. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
