 - 1. ENTERPRETT DEMINSIONIN AND TOLERENCING PER ANSI Y14.5M–1982.
 - 2. BURRS AND EDJES REMOV.
 - 3. ALL PHILLETS AND ROUNDS ARE .125 R.
 - 4. FINYIS ALL OVER.
- 4. Close the mtext editor.
- 5. Reopen the mtext editor. Check the spelling and correct the misspelled words.
- 6. Close the mtext editor.
- 7. Reopen the mtext editor. Make additional corrections to change the paragraph to read exactly as shown:
 - 1. DIMENSIONING AND TOLERANCING PER ASME Y14.5–2018.
 - 2. REMOVE ALL BURRS AND SHARP EDGES.
 - 3. FILLETS AND ROUNDS R.125.
 - 4. FINISH ALL OVER.
- 8. Resave and close the file.
- 9. Continue to practice using the AutoCAD spelling tools by completing the activities in act10-04.dwg available on the companion website.
- 10. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
