- 1. Continue from Exercise 12-8 or start AutoCAD.
- Start a new drawing from scratch or use an inch-unit template of your choice.Save the drawing as EX12-9.
- 3. Draw a single polyline object consisting of a straight line and arc, similar to the path shown in Figure 12-21.
- 4. Construct a rectangle centered on the endpoint of the polyline, similar to the source objects shown in Figure 12-21.
- 5. Create a non-associative rectangular array of the path and source objects. Use three columns, one row, and spacing between items similar to the spacing shown in Figure 12-21.
- 6. Create the three path arrays shown in Figure 12-21, but do not align the final array with the path.
- 7. Resave and close the file.
- 8. Keep AutoCAD open for the chapter review and problems, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
