Exercise 15-10

- 1. Continue from Exercise 15-9 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Save a copy of STOP RING REV0.dwg and STOP RING REV1.dwg from the companion website to the folder in which you save the exercises for this chapter.
- Use the COMPARE command to analyze the differences between the two drawings. Specify STOP RING REV0 as the base drawing and STOP RING REV1 as the reference drawing.
- 4. Use the proper option or command to experiment working with comparison drawings.
 - A. Toggle the draw order of objects unique to STOP RING REV0 and STOP RING REV1.
 - B. Hide and then redisplay objects unique to STOP RING REV0 and STOP
 RING REV1. Change the color assigned to STOP RING REV0 and STOP
 RING REV1 objects.
 - C. Hide and then redisplay objects common to both STOP RING REV0 and STOP RING REV1. Change the color assigned to common objects.
 - D. Import a single object from STOP RING REV1 into STOP RING REV0.
 - E. Toggle the display of all text and revision clouds.
 - F. Change the shape of revision clouds to polygonal and increase and decrease the size of the margin between change sets and revision clouds.
 - G. Adjust the margin until there are eight total change sets. Use the Next (right arrow) and Previous (left arrow) buttons to zoom in on change sets.
- 5. Export a snapshot of the drawing comparison. Save the snapshot using the default file name.
- Keep AutoCAD open for the chapter review and problems, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
