## **Exercise 20-2**

- 1. Continue from Exercise 20-1 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a decimal-unit template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX20-2.
- 3. Set up appropriate layers, including a layer for dimensions.
- 4. Draw and dimension the view shown in Figure 20-3 using an appropriate dimension style. Do not use the **Mtext** or **Text** option or add to the default dimension values while dimensioning.
- 5. Edit the 1.50 dimension to add the diameter symbol.
- 6. Edit the 2.250 dimension to place parentheses around the dimension value.
- 7. Resave and close the file.
- 8. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
