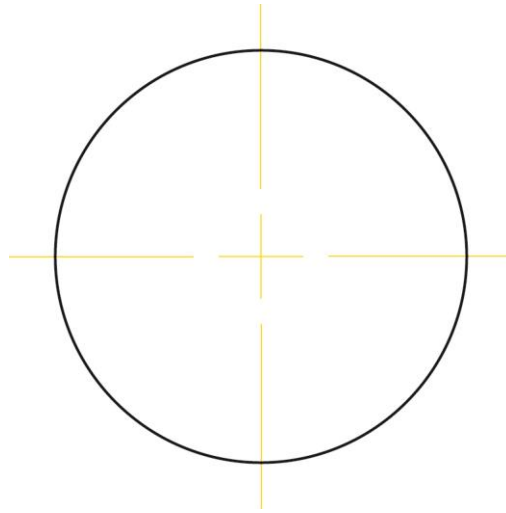


Exercise 24-1

1. Start AutoCAD if it is not already started.
2. Start a new drawing from scratch or use a decimal template of your choice. Save the drawing as EX24-1.
3. Set the 0 layer current. Draw a circle with a diameter of one unit and add centerlines as shown in the figure.



4. Create a block of the circle and centerlines and name it CIRCLE. Select the center of the circle as the insertion base point.
5. Resave and close the file.
6. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
