Exercise 28-3

- 1. Continue from Exercise 28-2 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX28-1 file you saved during Exercise 28-1.
- 3. Save a copy of EX28-1 as EX28-3. The EX28-3 file should be active.
- 4. Use the Quick View Layouts tool to delete Layout2.
- 5. Use the **Layout1** tab to change the name of **Layout1** to **A-Size**.
- 6. Access the **Page Setup Manager**. The default *A-Size* page setup should be highlighted. Pick the **Modify...** button to access the **Page Setup** dialog box.
- 7. Pick the arrow in the **Name:** drop-down list in the **Printer/plotter** area to view available plotting devices. Select a printer or plotter from the list that can plot an A-size sheet.
- 8. Select an A-size $(8.5'' \times 11'')$ sheet from the **Paper size** drop-down list.
- 9. Ensure that the **Landscape** radio button is selected in the **Drawing orientation** area.
- 10. Pick the **OK** button to exit the **Page Setup** dialog box, and pick the **Close** button to exit the **Page Setup Manager**.
- 11. Resave and close the drawing.
- 12. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
