Exercise 29-5

- 1. Continue from Exercise 29-4 or start AutoCAD.
- 2. Open the EX29-1 file you saved during Exercise 29-1.
- 3. Save a copy of EX29-1 as EX29-5. The EX29-5 file should be active.
- 4. Make the **A-Size** layout current.
- 5. Use grip editing or the **STRETCH** command to stretch the floating viewport to form a viewport that is 1/2" away from the border and title block. The layout may hide a portion of the model space drawing.
- 6. Create a new layer named VPORT. Use a yellow color, a Continuous linetype, and the default lineweight.
- 7. Move the floating viewport to the new VPORT layer.
- 8. Change the title in the title block from EXERCISE 29-1 to EXERCISE 29-5.
- 9. Resave and close the file.
- 10. Keep AutoCAD open for the next exercise, or exit AutoCAD if necessary.
