Exercise 18-2

- 1. Open the drawing **EX17-1** created in Exercise 17-1. If you have not completed this exercise, do so now.
- 2. Render the scene once for each of the render presets (draft, low, medium, high, presentation). In the **Render** window, note the differences in rendering time and image quality.
- 3. Open the **Advanced Render Settings** palette. In the **Indirect Illumination** category, enable global illumination. Using the default property settings, render the scene and note the differences in rendering time and image quality. If necessary, reduce the energy multiplier and render the scene again.
- 4. In the **Indirect Illumination** category in the **Advanced Render Settings** palette, enable final gathering. Using the default property settings, render the scene again. Note any differences in image quality.
- 5. Change the global illumination and final gathering properties to produce an acceptable final image.
- 6. Save the drawing as EX18-2.
