READ the case study

Helena's family child care home serves children ages six months to six years. Helena does not know how to handle a toy safety issue. The preschoolers want to play with smaller, more advanced toys that are inappropriate and unsafe for the younger children. Helena considers these options: offering only toys that are appropriate for all children, limiting use of smaller toys to younger children's naptimes, or provide a separate area for the older children to play with these toys.
