

Planograms

A planogram is a diagram that indicates the placement of products on shelves, walls, racks, or other types of displays. The diagram may also include props, graphics, lighting, mannequins, signage, and other items used to develop the product display. A planogram may be a picture, a diagram with product numbers, or a combination of the two. They are developed by merchandisers to ensure that product placement maximizes sales. When a retailer has more than one store, a planogram ensures that products are displayed consistently from store to store.
